

## **Dr. Dane Egli**

Dr. Dane Egli is a senior executive with experience at the White House, the Northern Command, the U.S. Coast Guard, and the private sector, developing and implementing national-level policy. He was Director for Counterterrorism on the National Security Council staff under President George W. Bush; Presidential Advisor for hostages; for international drug-control policy and Western Hemisphere counterterrorism and Maritime Domain Awareness. A career Coast Guard officer who commanded two ships conducting maritime security patrols and law enforcement operations in the Caribbean and Central/South America, he was Senior Advisor at Combatant Command Headquarters overseeing operational execution of joint service policy; he was Assistant Commandant at the Coast Guard Academy; he has seven years experience as professor of leadership studies, officership, and military strategy for future officers; he coordinated CGHQ preparations for congressional hearings; and he engaged congressional authorization and appropriations staff to formulate and execute a \$4B service budget.



Dr. Egli received his BS in civil engineering (with honors) from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy. He holds degrees and diplomas from the Naval War College and the National War College.
